The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §§ 31A-2-201 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Administrative Code Rule R590-160. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Commissioner, the Commissioner makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Respondent, Muyly H. Ung, is a resident insurance producer licensed in the State of Utah, License No. 231616.
2. Respondent submitted an application for renewal of his insurance producer license on or about October 1, 2007. As part of that application, Respondent submitted a check in the

amount of \$127.00, which was dishonored by the bank, returned marked “Insufficient Funds”.

3. As of the date of this proceeding, Respondent has failed to pay the amount due.

Having entered his Findings of Fact, the Commissioner now enters his:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has failed to meet the requirements for the renewal of his insurance producer’s license under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-10-5(1)(b)(x).
2. Respondent’s license should be revoked and ordered to cease doing any insurance business in the State of Utah.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commissioner now enters the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent’s Utah resident insurance producer’s license is revoked forthwith.
2. Respondent shall immediately cease doing any insurance business in the State of Utah.
3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.

NOTIFICATION

If you request a hearing regarding this matter, the department will be represented by M.




