FINDINGS AND ORDER SUSPENDING BAIL BOND AGENCY LICENSE

Findings

1. On January 23, 2020, B & B Bail Bonds was notified that the forfeiture judgment had not been paid in State v. Jennifer K Richardson Case No. 185107999.
2. B & B Bail Bonds did not pay the forfeiture judgment within 5 business days after receiving the notice.

Order

Pursuant to Utah Code §§ 31A-2-201(4) and 31A-35-504(3), it is ordered:

1. B & B Bail Bond agency license is suspended effective the date of this order.
2. The suspension will remain in effect for a minimum of 14 days and will not be lifted unless the following requirements are met:
 - the prosecutor in State v. Jennifer K Richardson Case No. 185107999, has given written notice that the judgment has been paid;
 - for any other notice of an unpaid forfeiture judgment, the prosecutor in that case has given written notice that the judgment has been paid.
