 - a. If a hearing were held, witnesses called by the Complainant could offer and introduce evidence that would support the Findings of Fact herein;
 - b. Respondent admits the Findings of Fact and Conclusions made therefrom;
 - c. Respondent stipulates to the summary entry of the Order herein which shall be in lieu of other administrative proceedings by Complainant in this matter; and

d. Respondent and Complainant have negotiated the terms of the Order entered herein and Respondent agrees to its entry and further agrees to be bound by all its terms.

3. Respondent is aware of his right to a hearing at which he may be represented by counsel, present evidence and cross-examine witnesses. Respondent has irrevocably waived his right to such hearing and to any appeal related thereto.


4. Respondent admits the jurisdiction of the State of Utah Insurance Commissioner as to all matters herein.

5. Respondent is acting herein free from any duress or coercion of any kind or nature, having been advised fully as to his rights set forth herein.

6. Respondent acknowledges that the issuance of this Order by the Commissioner is solely for the purpose of disposition of the matter entitled herein.

Based upon the foregoing Stipulation and information in the file, the Presiding Officer makes the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about May 19, 2008, Respondent submitted an application for a resident insurance agent's license in the State of Utah.
2. In his application Respondent answered "No" to the question "Have you ever been convicted of ... a crime...?"
3. At the time Respondent submitted his application he knew that he had be convicted of two counts of theft, class B misdemeanors on January 30, 1996, in the Utah Fifth District Court, Cedar City, Iron County, and was also convicted of one count of gambling by a minor, a misdemeanor, on March 3, 1997, in Mesquite, Nevada.

Based upon the foregoing Stipulation and Findings of Fact, the Presiding Officer enters the following Conclusions of Law:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. In falsely stating in his insurance agent license application that he had not be convicted of a crime when such was not the case, Respondent violated Utah Code Annotated §§ 31A-23a-105(2) and 31A-2-202(6).
2. In making false statements on his insurance agent license application, Respondent brings into question whether he meets the character requirements to hold an insurance agent's license of competent and trustworthy under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-107(2).

Based upon the foregoing Stipulation, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the

Presiding Officer herewith enters the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent is assessed an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00, to be paid within 30 days of the date of this Order.
2. Upon payment of the forfeiture assessed herein, the department shall issue an insurance agent's license as applied for. Said license shall be issued on a probationary status for a period of 12 months. The terms of the probation are that Respondent shall have no further violations of the Utah Insurance Code or Rules or of any Order of the commissioner.


NOTIFICATION

Respondent is hereby notified that failure to abide by the terms of this Order may subject you to further penalties, including additional forfeitures of up to \$2,500.00 per violation and the suspension or revocation of your license, and the filing of an action to enforce this Order in the District Court, which may impose penalties of up to \$10,000.00 per day for continued violation.

You are further notified that other jurisdictions in which you may be licensed may require that you report this action to them.


