

1. The bail bond surety license of Respondent All American Bail Bonds is hereby revoked forthwith.
2. The bail bond agent's license of Respondent Christopher Alan DeMartini is hereby revoked forthwith.
3. Respondents shall immediately cease doing any bail bond business in the State of Utah and shall not be an owner, directly or indirectly on any entity doing bail bond business in the State of Utah and shall not act as an officer, director, employee or agent of any entity doing bail bond business in this State.


NOTIFICATION

Respondents are hereby notified that failure to abide by the terms of this Order may subject them to further penalties, including additional forfeitures of up to \$5,000.00 per violation and the filing of an action to enforce this Order in the District Court, which may impose penalties of up to \$10,000.00 per day for continued violation.

You are further notified that other jurisdictions in which you may be licensed may require that you report this action to them.
