Based upon the foregoing Stipulation and information in the file, the Presiding Officer makes the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- On September 7, 2011, a Market Conduct examiner conducted an audit of Respondent, 2nd Chance Bail Bonds.
- 2. The audit revealed that Respondents were using outdated disclosure forms. The forms used by Respondents were not updated to reflect the 10% minimum bond premium or other rule changes.
- 3. Respondent Tony Choate admits that he failed to use the new forms issued by his surety which incorporated the 10% minimum bail premium rule and additional changes made by Department Rule R590-196-6.
 - 4. Respondents agree to a joint administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00.

Based upon the foregoing Stipulation and Findings of Fact, the Presiding Officer enters the following Conclusions of Law:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Utah Administrative Code R590-196-6 sets forth the appropriate Disclosure Form which must include the 10% minimum bond premium rule.
 - 2. The Respondents were using outdated forms and in doing so violated R590-196-6.
- 3. A joint administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00 is appropriate under the circumstances.

Based upon the foregoing Stipulation, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Presiding Officer herewith enters the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondents 2nd Chance Bail Bonds and Tony Choate are jointly and severally assessed an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00 to be paid to the Utah Department of Insurance within 30 days of the issuance of this Order.
