The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §§ 31A-2-201 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Administrative Code Rule R590-160. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Commissioner, the Commissioner makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a resident licensed title insurance agent with a marketing line of authority, holding License number 399768.
- 2. Respondent submitted an application for a title insurance agent's license with a marketing line of authority on October 6, 2011. In his application, Respondent answered "No" to the question "Have you ever been convicted of ... a crime...?"

3. At the time of the submission of his application, Respondent knew that he had nine misdemeanor convictions between June 1995 and October 2005.

Having entered his Findings of Fact, the Commissioner now enters his:

## **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

- 1. In submitting false information on his license application by stating he had not been convicted of a crime when he had nine convictions, Respondent violated Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-105(2) and 31A-2-202(6).
- 2. In providing false information on his license application, Respondent brings into question his qualification to hold an insurance agent's license under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-107(2) as being competent and trustworthy.
- 3. In violating insurance statutes, Respondent is subject to imposition of forfeitures of up to \$5,000.00 per violation under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-2-308, and is subject to the revocation or suspension of his license under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-111(5)(b), or having his license placed on probation under Utah Code Annotated § 31A-23a-112.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commissioner now enters the following:

## **RECOMMENDED ORDER**

IT RECOMMENDED THAT THE TITLE AND ESCROW COMMISSION IMPOSE THE FOLLOWING PENALTY:

1. Respondent be assessed an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00, to be paid within 10 days of the date this Order becomes final.

2. Respondent's license be placed on probation for a period of 24 months from the date this Order becomes final. The terms of probation to be:

a. Respondent shall pay the administrative forfeiture assessed herein in a timely manner;

b. Respondent shall be personally supervised by Douglas Stanley of United Title Services of Southern Utah, or by another licensee approved by the department;

c. Respondent shall have no further violations of the Utah Insurance Code or Rules or of any order of the commissioner;

d. during the period of probation Respondent shall not commit any criminal acts, other than minor traffic violations; and

e. during the period of probation, Respondent shall not apply for any other line of authority or for any other insurance license.

3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.
