MOTION FOR ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Comes now, M. Gale Lemmon, attorney for Complainant, and hereby moves the commissioner for an Order to Show Cause why Respondent's Utah insurance agent's license should not be revoked for failure to obey an Order of the commissioner in the above-entitled matter. In support of its motion, Complainant shows as follows:

1. Complainant instituted an informal administrative proceeding against Respondent on August 14, 2012, and on August 23, 2012, mailed the Notice Of Informal Adjudicative Proceeding and Order to Respondent at the following address:

a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

2. Respondent did not request a hearing and the Order became final on September 7, 2012, and is not subject to agency review or appeal.

3. Respondent failed to obey the Order of the commissioner in failing to pay an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00 and failed to respond to an inquiry of the commissioner.

4. Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 31A-2-308, if a licensee fails to obey an order of the commissioner, he may assess forfeitures of up to \$2,500.00 per violation or may suspend or revoke Respondent's license.

5. Because Respondent failed to obey the Order previously made in this matter, the commissioner should now revoke Respondent's license and order Respondent to pay an additional administrative forfeiture in an amount to be designated by the commissioner for violation of that Order.

TIME: at the hour of 9:00 a..m.



**NOTICE OF INFORMAL
ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING
AND ORDER**

Failure to Respond

The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Annotated (U.C.A.) § 31A-2-202 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Administrative Code (U.A.C.) Rule R590-160. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Commissioner, the Commissioner makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is an agent authorized to do the business of insurance in the State of Utah holding License number 393937.
2. The Respondent failed to properly respond to the initial inquiry of the Commissioner dated March 9, 2012.

3. The Respondent failed to properly respond to a second inquiry of the Commissioner dated May 15, 2012.

4. The Respondent failed to properly respond to a third inquiry of the Commissioner dated June 22, 2012.

5. The Respondent failed to properly respond a fourth inquiry of the Commissioner dated July 12, 2012.

6. On August 9, 2012, attempts to reach the Respondent by phone, as listed in Department records, were unsuccessful.

7. As of August 10, 2012, no response from the Respondent has been received.

8. As of the date of this Notice of Informal Adjudicative Proceeding and Order, no response has been received and the time for response and any extensions granted has expired.

Having entered his Findings of Fact, the Commissioner now enters his:

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. In failing to submit a timely response to an inquiry from the Commissioner, the Respondent violated U.C.A. Subsection 31A-2-202(4).

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commissioner now enters the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall pay an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00. Said forfeiture shall be paid no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.

2. Respondent shall provide a substantive response to the Commissioner's inquiries to be received in the offices of the Utah Insurance Department no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.

3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.

NOTIFICATION

If you request a hearing regarding this matter, the department will be represented by M. Gale Lemmon, Assistant Attorney General, 160 E. 300 S., Fifth Floor, P.O. Box 140874, Salt Lake City, UT 84114-0874, Telephone Number (801) 366-0375. Failure to request a hearing will be considered a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any further administrative or judicial review or appeal of this matter.


You are further notified that a failure to obey an Order of the commissioner may subject you to further penalties, including forfeitures of up to \$2,500.00 per violation and the suspension or revocation of your license of the filing of an action to enforce this Order in District Court which may impose forfeitures of up to \$10,000.00 per day for continued violation.

You are further notified that other jurisdictions in which you may be licensed may require that you report this action to them.

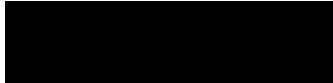
