The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Annotated (U.C.A.) §§ 31A-2-202 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Administrative Code (U.A.C.) Rule R590-160. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Commissioner, the Commissioner makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is an agent authorized to do the business of insurance in the State of Utah holding License number 212884.
 - 2. The Respondent failed to properly respond to an initial inquiry of the Commissioner dated March 8, 2012.

- 3. The Respondent failed to respond to a 2nd and final notice from the Utah producer licensing division on May 11, 2012.
- 4. On December 5, 2012 the Respondent stated by telephone she would provide a copy of the Stipulation and Order from Arkansas to the MCE. A response was not provided.
- 5. On December 11, 2012 the Respondent told the MCE over the telephone she would make sure the examiner received the response and would follow up with a telephone call to the MCE for receipt confirmation. No response was given.
- 6. The Respondent failed to return a telephone call from the MCE on December 13, 2012.

Having entered his Findings of Fact, the Commissioner now enters his:

CONCLUSION OF LAW

l. In failing to submit a timely response to an inquiry from the Commissioner, the Respondent violated U.C.A. Subsection 31A-2-202(4).

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commissioner now enters the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent shall pay an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00. Said forfeiture shall be paid no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.
- 2. Respondent shall provide a substantive response to the Commissioner's inquiries to be received in the offices of the Utah Insurance Department no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.
 - 3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a

written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.
