The Utah Insurance Department ("Department"), by and through its attorney, Perri Ann Babalis, Assistant Attorney General, and B & B Bail Bonds ("Respondent"), a licensed resident limited line producer organization, hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

STIPULATION

- 1. Respondent, B & B Bail Bonds, is a licensed resident limited line producer organization, holding license number 97862. Respondent's mailing address is
- Respondent admits that the Utah Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over Respondent and over the subject matter of this action.
- 3. Respondent acknowledges notice of agency action pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-210; further acknowledges that this Stipulation and Order is an informal proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-202; and waives the right to any hearing in this matter.
- Respondent affirms that Respondent enters into this stipulation voluntarily and knowingly.
- 5. Respondent affirms that the only promises, agreements, or understandings the Respondent has obtained from the Department or from an agent or representative of the Department regarding this stipulation are contained herein.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that Respondent has the right to be represented by legal counsel and that Respondent has consulted legal counsel with regards to this stipulation.
- 7. The parties acknowledge that upon approval by the Respondent and the Department, this stipulation shall be made a part of the attached final Order, and shall be the final compromise and settlement of this matter, and is not subject to agency review, reconsideration, renegotiation, modification, appeal, or hearing.
 - 8. Respondent admits on or about November 12, 2013, the Department sent Respondent a

letter to the address listed in SIRCON. The letter was returned to sender, as Respondent's address was no longer valid.

- 9. Respondent admits that it failed to inform the Commissioner of its new business address within 20 days of obtaining the new address.
- 10. Respondent admits that it failed to file with the Commissioner updated forms containing Respondent's new address, within 30 days from the date of changing its address.
- 11. Respondent admits that the above acts and practices constitute violations of the Utah Insurance Code. Specifically, Respondent admits that Respondent has violated:
- a. Utah Code Ann. § 31A-35-602, in that Respondent failed to notify the Commissioner of its new address within 20 days of an address change; and
- b. Utah Code Ann. § 31A-35-607, in that Respondent failed to file updated forms with the Commissioner within 30 days of a change in the forms
- 12. As full settlement of all of the issues raised in the stipulation, Respondent agrees to pay a forfeiture of \$1,750.00 to the Department, due within 30 days from the date of the Order;
