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**NOTICE OF INFORMAL  
AGENCY ACTION  
AND ORDER**

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The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 31A-2-201, 31A-3-103 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Admin. Code R590-102. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Department, the Department asserts the following facts:

**FACTS**

1. Respondent is a licensed insurance producer authorized to do the business of insurance in the State of Utah holding License Number 462414.
2. On or about September 21, 2013, Respondent applied for a Resident Individual Producer license. Respondent indicated on the application that he was 96 months in arrears with child support obligations and that he was compliant with the repayment agreement. Respondent provided court documents disclosing the amount of arrears as \$1,181.78.

3. On or about October 3, 2013, Respondent's license was issued.
4. On or about November 26, 2013, the State of Wisconsin denied Respondent's license application.
5. On or about June 4, 2014, the Department mailed and emailed a Letter of Memorandum to Respondent, requesting that he disclose the administrative action in the State of Wisconsin. No response was received.
6. On August 5, 2014, the Department attempted to contact Respondent via mail to the residential address on file. No response was received.
7. On or about September 15, 2014, contact was established with Respondent via a phone call. Respondent agreed to update contact information with the Department and provide a statement regarding the Wisconsin license denial.
8. On or about September 19, 2014, Respondent provided a statement via email that he was not aware of the Wisconsin administrative action. He agreed to update his contact information.
9. On or about September 22, 2014, the Department contacted Respondent via email, again requesting that he update his contact information with the Department. No response was received.
10. On December 29, 2014, the Department again contacted Respondent via email, requesting that he update his contact information with the Department. No response was received.
11. A review of the Utah Courts Exchange website indicates that Respondent had a second child support lien that was not disclosed at the time of application. As of April 22, 2015, Respondent is in arrears \$24,600.06.

12. As of today, April 23, 2015, Respondent has failed to update his contact information with the Department.

13. As of today, April 23, 2015, Respondent has failed to respond to the inquiry of the Commissioner.

**BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FACTS**

1. Respondent has violated §31A-23a-105(2) by failing to disclose an administrative action in another state within 30 day of the final disposition.
2. Respondent has violated §31A-23a-412(1) by failing to notify the commissioner within 30 days of any change in address or business email address.
3. Respondent has violated §31A-2-202 by failing to promptly respond to an inquiry of the commissioner.

Based upon the foregoing facts, the Commissioner now enters the following Order:


**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Respondent's license is herein revoked.
2. Respondent is prohibited from conducting insurance business in the State of Utah.
3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the Department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.

If you request a hearing regarding this matter, please contact the Examiner, Jen Christian, at 801-538-3172. Failure to request a hearing will be considered a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any further administrative or judicial review or appeal of this matter.

You are further notified that a failure to obey an Order of the commissioner may subject you to further penalties, including forfeitures of up to \$2,500.00 per violation and the suspension or revocation of your license and the filing of an action to enforce this Order in District Court, which may impose forfeitures of up to \$10,000.00 per day for continued violation.

You are further notified that other jurisdictions in which you may be licensed may require that you report this action to them.
