**NOTICE OF INFORMAL  
AGENCY ACTION

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The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 31A-2-201, 31A-3-103 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Admin. Code R590-102. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Department, the Department asserts the following facts:

**FACTS**

1. Respondent is a licensed resident limited line producer organization authorized to do the business of insurance in the State of Utah holding License Number 344025.

2. Respondent failed to properly respond to an inquiry of the Commissioner, dated May 27, 2015, and sent to Respondent's following address on file with the Department: [REDACTED] and emailed to [superiorbailbonds@gmail.com](mailto:superiorbailbonds@gmail.com). Response was due on June 29, 2015.

3. Respondent's attorney Eric Lind, emailed a request dated June 26, 2015 asking for a later date for the response. The request was granted, with the date of July 10, 2015 given.

4. Respondent's attorney Eric Lind, emailed a request dated July 9, 2015 asking for a later date for the response. The request was granted, with the date of July 17, 2015 given.

5. Respondent failed to provide the requested information on July 17, 2015.

#### BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FACTS

Based upon the foregoing facts, the Commissioner now enters the following Order:

#### **ORDER**

##### **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Respondent's is assessed an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00. Said forfeiture shall be paid no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.

2. Respondent shall provide a substantive response to the Commissioner's inquiries regarding the lack of payment of fees.

3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the Department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.


administrative remedies and will preclude any further administrative or judicial review or appeal of this matter.
