Re: Renewal Application for a Utah Resident Producer Individual License

Mr. White:

Your license renewal application for a resident limited line producer individual license in Utah has been approved with the license to be renewed on a probationary basis for a period of 24 months effective July 31, 2014. The license is being placed on probation upon renewal of the license due to the following:

- <u>UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xxi)</u> Failure to comply with an administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation.
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(iv) Failure to pay a final judgment or judgments rendered against you in this state.

The terms of probation are as follows:

- Maintain compliance during the probationary period with any administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation, including compliance with any repayment agreement concerning any child support obligation in arrearage.
- All outstanding debt collection judgments rendered against you in this state shall be paid in full during the probationary period.
- You shall not commit any crime nor violate any Utah Insurance Code or Rule or any order of the Commissioner.

This issuance of your license on a probationary status constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any administrative or judicial review of this order. Should you request a hearing, the request must be in writing, signed by the party making the request, and must be received by the department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of this letter. Any such request should specifically state the relief requested, should explain in reasonable detail the basis on which you believe such relief should be granted, and should be addressed to: Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, Suite 3110 State Office Building, PO Box 146901, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6901.
