Re: Application for Utah Resident Producer Individual License

Mr. Guevara,

The denial letter dated March 25, 2015 denying your license application dated March 17, 2015 for a resident individual producer license in Utah, is hereby withdrawn. Your license application has instead been approved with the license issued on a probationary basis for a period of 24 months effective today, March 30, 2015. The license is being placed on probation upon issuance of the license due to failure to meet the trustworthy requirement under UCA 31A-23a-107 in light of the December 2011 shoplifting incident, and due to your failure to pay a May 2013 final judgment rendered against you in this state.

The terms of probation are as follows:

 You shall not commit any crime nor violate any Utah Insurance Code or Rule or any order of the Commissioner during the probationary period, and you must pay during the probationary period any outstanding judgment against you.

This issuance of your license on a probationary status constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will predude any administrative or judicial review of this order. Should you request a hearing, the request must be in writing, signed by the party making the request, and must be received by the department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of this letter. Any such request should specifically state the relief requested, should explain in reasonable detail the basis on which you believe such relief should be granted, and should be addressed to: Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, Suite 3110 State Office Building, PO Box 146901, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6901.
