**NOTICE OF INFORMAL  
AGENCY ACTION  
AND ORDER**

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The Utah Insurance Department has commenced this informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 31A-2-201, 31A-3-103 and 63G-4-201 and Utah Admin. Code R590-102. Based upon information contained in agency files or known to the Department, the Department asserts the following facts:

**FACTS**

1. Respondent is a licensed insurance producer authorized to do the business of insurance in the State of Utah holding License Number 363894.
2. On March 26, 2015, Respondent was assessed a fine in the amount of \$1,000 in the State of Rhode Island for failure to respond.

3. On July 31, 2015, the Utah Insurance Department attempted to contact Respondent via mail and email. No response was received.

4. On August 26, 2015, the Department attempted to contact Respondent via mail and email. No response was received.

5. On September 10, 2015, the Department attempted to contact Respondent via phone. No response was received.

6. As of today, September 21, 2015, Respondent has failed to respond to any of the Department's attempts to contact him. Respondent has violated §31A-2-202 by failing to respond to the inquiry of the Commissioner.

### **BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FACTS**

1. In failing to submit a timely response to an inquiry from the Commissioner, the Respondent violated Utah Code Ann. § 31A-2-201.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commissioner now enters the following:

### **ORDER**

#### **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**


1. Respondent's is assessed an administrative forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00. Said forfeiture shall be paid no later than ten (10) days after the date this Order becomes final.

2. Respondent shall provide a substantive response to the Commissioner's inquiries regarding the lack of payment of fees.

3. This Order shall become final fifteen (15) days after the date of mailing unless a written request for a hearing is received from the Respondent in the offices of the Department prior to that date. A written request for a hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state the basis for the relief requested.
