Re: Application for Utah Non-Resident Adjuster Individual License

Mr. Eicholtz,

Your application for a non-resident producer individual license in Utah dated December 9, 2015, is hereby **denied**. The denial is based on one or more of the following:

- UCA 31A-26-213(5)(b)(ix) – Providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application.
- UCA 31A-26-203(2)(b) – Failing to report an administrative taken against you in another jurisdiction.

This denial of your application constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any administrative or judicial review of this order. Should you request a hearing, the request must be in writing, signed by the party making the request, and must be received by the department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of this denial letter. Any such request should specifically state the relief requested, should explain in reasonable detail the basis on which you believe such relief should be granted, and should be addressed to: Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, Suite 3110 State Office Building, PO Box 146901, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6901.
