Your application for a resident limited line producer individual license in Utah dated November 23, 2015, is hereby **denied**. The denial is based on one or more of the following:

- <u>UCA 31A-23a-107</u> failure to meet the trustworthy character requirement for licensing;
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xiv) –convicted of a felony;
- <u>UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xxiii)</u> convicted of a felony involving dishonesty in violation of 18 U.S.C. Section 1033 and therefore under 18 U.S.C. Section 1033 is prohibited from engaging in the business of insurance.
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(iv) failure to timely pay a final judgment rendered against you in this state;
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(i) unqualified for a license.

This denial of your application constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any administrative or judicial review of this order.
