Re: Application for Utah Resident Limited Line Producer Individual License

Mr. Hustead,

Your application for a resident limited line producer individual license in Utah dated December 7, 2015, is hereby **denied**. The denial is based on one or more of the following:

- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xiv) –convicted of a felony;
- <u>UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xxiii)</u> convicted of a felony involving dishonesty in violation of 18 U.S.C. Section 1033 and therefore under 18 U.S.C. Section 1033 is prohibited from engaging in the business of insurance;
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(iv) failure to pay a state income tax.
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(iv) failure to timely pay a final judgment rendered against you in this state;
- <u>UCA § 31A-23a-104</u> committing an act that is a ground for denial, suspension, or revocation as set forth in <u>UCA § 31A-23a-105</u> or 111.
- UCA 31A-23a-107 failure to meet the trustworthy character requirement for licensing;
- UCA 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(i) unqualified for a license.

This denial of your application constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any administrative or judicial review of this order. Should you request a hearing, the request must be in writing, signed by the party making the request, and must be received by the department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of this denial letter. Any such request should specifically state the relief requested, should explain in reasonable detail the basis on which you believe such relief should be granted, and should be addressed to: Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, Suite 3110 State Office Building, PO Box 146901, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6901.
