Re: Application for Renewal of Utah Non-Resident Producer Individual License

Mr. Paras:

Your application for the February 29, 2016 renewal of your Utah non-resident producer individual license is hereby **denied**. The denial is based on one or more of the following:

- UCA 31A-23a-2-202(4) failure to respond to a reasonable written inquiry from the commissioner;
- <u>UCA 31A-23a-105(2)(b)&(c)</u> failure to report at within 30 days of the final disposition an administrative action taken against you by the state of Indiana;
- UCA 31A-23a-105(2)111(5)(b)(ii) violation of an insurance statute.

This denial of your license renewal application constitutes an order of the commissioner in an informal adjudicative proceeding under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act (Utah Code Annotated §§ 63G-4-101, et seq.) and shall become final fifteen (15) days after mailing, unless you request an administrative hearing to contest this decision. Failure to request a hearing constitutes a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any administrative or judicial review of this order. Should you request a hearing, the request must be in writing, signed by the party making the request, and must be received by the department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of this denial letter. Any such request should specifically state the relief requested, should explain in reasonable detail the basis on which you believe such relief should be granted, and should be addressed to: Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, Suite 3110 State Office Building, PO Box 146901, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6901.
