DISMISSAL ORDER

This matter came before the undersigned for an evidentiary hearing on September 4, 2019. The matter was recorded. Respondent Steven Bryce Romero was self-represented and appeared telephonically after a short delay. Utah Insurance Department (hereafter “Complainant”) was represented by Ms. Helen Frohlich, Assistant Attorney General, and Mr. Randy Overstreet, Division Director of Producer Licensing, were present in person.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. This matter was commenced on July 9, 2019, when Respondent filed a request for an insurance license.
2. On July 25, 2019, Respondent’s request was denied on several grounds including several misdemeanor convictions.
3. On July 25, 2019, Respondent filed his Request for Review of Agency Action.
4. On July 2, 2015, Respondent was convicted of Theft by Receiving Stolen Property, a Class A Misdemeanor, which is a crime involving fraud, misrepresentation, theft, or

dishonesty.

5. On April 16, 2018, Respondent's probation was terminated successfully.
6. Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R590-281-4(1)(c)(ii), Respondent is ineligible to apply for a license until five years have elapsed since probation was terminated successfully on the Class A Misdemeanor.

ANALYSIS


At the outset of the hearing, Respondent verbally requested to dismiss this matter with prejudice. There was no objection from Complainant.

ORDER

Based upon Respondent's verbal motion, and for good cause, it is therefore ORDERED that this matter is DISMISSED with prejudice. The case is closed.
