This matter came before the undersigned for a prehearing telephonic conference on March 19, 2020. The matter was recorded. Respondent Colston Robinson appeared with his attorney, Roy D. Cole. Complainant's attorney, Edward Vasquez, Assistant Attorney General, and Randy Overstreet, Director of the Producer Licensing Division, were present.

This matter was commenced on February 20, 2020, when Respondent filed a request for hearing to appeal Complainant's denial of his application for a Utah resident producer individual insurance license, dated February 6, 2020.

Both parties stipulated to have the appeal withdrawn and the hearing request dismissed without prejudice. Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R590-281-4(1) and (4), Respondent is ineligible to apply for a license at this time. The department's denial of the license application is proper.

Based upon parties' stipulation at hearing, and for good cause, it is therefore **ORDERED** that this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice and the case is closed.
