This matter came before the undersigned on April 16, 2020, at 1:15 p.m., for a telephonic prehearing conference. The matter was recorded. Respondent Andrea Daniela Garzon was self-represented. Mr. Edward Vasquez, Assistant Attorney General, appeared for the Utah Insurance Department, Complainant. Mr. Randy Overstreet, Director, Producer Licensing Division, Utah Insurance Department, was also present.

**PROCEDURAL FACTS**

On March 4, 2020, Respondent filed an application for licensure for a resident limited line producer individual insurance. On April 2, 2020, the Complainant denied her license application. On April 3, 2020, Petitioner filed a Request for Hearing. On April 10, 2020, the matter was converted to a formal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-4-202(3) and set for prehearing conference.

At the telephonic prehearing conference, after some discussion among the parties


regarding the implementation of Utah Admin. Code R590-281-4(1)(c), Respondent verbally made a motion to withdraw her hearing request for review of the denial of her license application. There was no objection. Respondent's license application is deemed denied. Respondent may reapply for licensure upon the expiration of three years after the date of completion of probation, which would be August 8, 2022.

Respondent's motion to withdraw is GRANTED.

Based on the law and facts herein, and for good cause, it is therefore ORDERED that this hearing request is DISMISSED without prejudice and the case is closed.
