# ORDER GRANTING DEPARTMENT'S MOTION FOR DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

This matter came before the undersigned on March 29, 2022, for a scheduled telephonic prehearing conference. Helen Frohlich, Assistant Attorney General, appeared for the Utah Insurance Department (hereafter "the Department"). Respondent Justin Allan Boldt (hereafter "Respondent") appeared and was represented by James Dunn, Esq.

#### PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On March 16, 2022, the Department issued a Notice of Agency Action and Order denying Respondent's application for a Utah resident individual producer insurance license. On March 22, 2022, Respondent filed a timely hearing request in writing to challenge the Department's denial of his license application. A prehearing conference was then scheduled and duly noticed to the parties.

At the prehearing conference on March 29, 2022, Respondent and his counsel agreed to a stay of his request for hearing pending respondent's filing of an Application to the Utah Insurance Commissioner for Written Consent to Engage in the Business of Insurance, pursuant to

18 U.S.C. Sec. 1033 and Sec. 1034. Respondent subsequently filed said application with the Utah Insurance Commissioner, who denied the application on June 13, 2022.

On July 12, 2022, the Department filed its pending Motion to Dismiss Respondent's request for hearing. The time period for filing a written response to the Department's motion provided by the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure expired and Respondent did not file a response.

#### **JURISDICTION**

The undersigned is duly appointed to serve as presiding officer in the above-entitled matter, and has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Utah Code §§ 63G-4-201 through 203 and Utah Admin. Code R590-160.

#### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing, and for good cause shown, the undersigned hereby enters the following Order:

- 1. The Department's Motion to Dismiss Respondent's Request for Hearing is hereby **GRANTED**.
  - 2. Respondent's Request for Hearing is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
- 3. The Department's Order dated March 16, 2022, denying Respondent's application for licensure as a resident individual insurance producer is hereby **AFFIRMED.**
