FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

Complainant, Utah Insurance Department ("Department") and Respondent, Opticare of Utah, Inc., have stipulated to the entry of the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

Based upon that stipulation, and good cause appearing, the Presiding Officer makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is an insurer holding a certificate of authority, Utah number 1667.
- 2. Respondent's mailing address is
- 3. Pursuant to Utah Code §31A-4-113(1) an insurer is required to file annually with the commissioner, before March 1st, a true statement of the authorized insurer's financial condition,

transactions, and affairs as of December 31st of the preceding year.

- 4. Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R590-254-4, an insurer shall have an annual audit by an independent certified public accountant and shall file an audited financial report with the commissioner on or before June 1st for the preceding year ending December 31st.
- 5. On July 12, 2021, Respondent failed to meet its filing extension deadline by filing its March 31, 2021, quarterly statement twelve days past the deadline. This violated Utah Code §§ 31A-4-113(1) and 31A-4-113.5(1). The Department chose not to seek a forfeiture for this violation because it was a first-time occurrence, and the delay was not substantial.
- 6. However, Respondent again failed to meet its filing extension deadline when it failed to file its March 31, 2022, quarterly statement by the filing extension date of May 31, 2022. This violated Utah Code §§ 31A-4-113(1) and 31A-4-113.5(1).
- 7. Respondent failed to file its June 1, 2022, Audited Financial Statement for the preceding year ending December 31, 2021, by the filing extension date of June 30, 2022. This violated Utah Admin. Code R590-254-4.
- 8. On October 12, 2022, the Respondent was assessed a \$2,500.00 forfeiture as a result of these violations. (See UID v. Opticare of Utah, Inc., Docket No. 2022-4430).
- 9. Respondent continued to fail to file its December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statements, in violation of Utah Admin. Code R590-254-4 and the Utah Insurance Commissioner's ("Commissioner) order. On February 9, 2023, the Department assessed a second forfeiture of \$5,000.00 for the violation. (See UID v. Opticare of Utah, Inc., Docket No. 2023-4468).
 - 10. To date, Respondent has continued to violate Utah Admin. Code R590-254-4 and the

Commissioner's order by failing to file its December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statements.

- 11. Respondent also failed to file its December 31, 2022, Annual Statement by the filing extension date of April 1, 2023, in violation of Utah Code §§ 31A-4-113(1) and 31A-4-113.5(1).
- 12. The Department and Respondent have agreed to an administrative forfeiture of \$10,000.00, and thereafter, beginning on April 19, 2023, a forfeiture amount of \$1,000.00 per day for each day until the December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statement is filed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Utah Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner") has jurisdiction over the parties and this adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code §§ 31A-1-105 and 31A-2-201.
- 2. The Commissioner has legal authority to impose penalties on the Department's licensees who violate the Utah Insurance Code. Utah Code § 31A-2-308.
- 3. Respondent violated Utah Code §§ 31A-4-113(1) and 31A-4-113.5(1), when it failed to file its December 31, 2022, Annual Statement by the filing extension date of April 1, 2023.
- 4. Respondent violated Utah Admin Rule R590-254-4, when it failed to file its December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statement.
- 5. As a penalty for the violations in this case, Respondent should be ordered to pay a forfeiture of \$10,000.00, and beginning on April 19, 2023, Respondent should be ordered to pay a forfeiture amount of \$1,000.00 per day for each day until the December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statement is filed.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby Ordered

that:

1. Respondent shall pay a forfeiture of \$10,000.00 for the violations described in the

Conclusions of Law. Payment in full is due within thirty days of this order.

2. Beginning April 19, 2023, Respondent shall pay a forfeiture amount of \$1,000.00 per

day for each day until the December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Statement is filed.

3. Respondent is ordered not to commit the violations described in the Conclusions of

Law in the future.
