NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION

The Utah Insurance Department ("the Department") commences this agency action as an informal adjudicative proceeding against Respondent Dallon Creed Slaughter ("Respondent") pursuant to Utah Code §§ 31A-2-201 and 63G-4-201 through -203 and to Utah Admin. Code R590-160.

This agency action is based on the facts and law set forth in the attached Declaration and is designated as an informal adjudicative proceeding pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-4-202(1) and Utah Admin Code R590-160-4 and -7.

ORDER

Based on the facts and the law set forth in the attached Declaration, and good cause appearing, the Utah Insurance Commissioner orders as follows:

1. Respondent's application for a Utah resident producer individual insurance license is

denied.

2. Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-4-203(1)(i) and Utah Admin. Code R590-160-7(1), this

informal adjudicative proceeding shall be closed, and this Order shall become final and take full

effect, 15 days after this Notice of Agency Action and Order is emailed to Respondent unless a

request for a hearing on this matter is received from Respondent prior to that date.

3. A request for a hearing shall be in writing and sent by email to

uidadmincases@utah.gov or by U.S. mail to Office of the Administrative Law Judge, Utah

Insurance Department, 4315 S. 2700 W., Suite 2300, Taylorsville, UT 84129.

4. The request for hearing shall be signed by the person making the request and shall state

the basis for the relief requested.

5. If you fail to request a hearing you will be bound by this Order. Failure to request a

hearing will be deemed a failure to exhaust administrative remedies and will preclude any further

administrative or judicial review or appeal of this matter.

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NOTICE REGARDING ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDER

Failure to obey the Order may subject you to further penalties that include a forfeiture of up to \$2,500 per violation, with each day of the violation constituting a separate violation. Other penalties for failing to obey this Order include license suspension, probation, refusal to renew, or revocation. Failure to obey this Order may also result in an action being taken against you in a court of competent where forfeitures of up to \$10,000 for each day the failure to comply continues until judgement is rendered. If you are licensed in other jurisdictions, you may be required to report this proceeding to those jurisdictions.

DECLARATION

Under criminal penalty of Utah law, I, Randy Overstreet, declare the following:

- 1. I am currently employed as Manager of Producer Licensing in the Financial Regulation & Licensing Division with the Utah Insurance Department ("Department") where my responsibilities include investigating and enforcing Utah insurance laws.
- 2. I submit this Declaration as the basis for issuing the Notice of Agency Action and Order against Dallon Creed Slaughter ("Respondent") to which this Declaration is attached.
- 3. Based on my personal knowledge and/or based on the facts appearing in the Department's records and files, the following facts are true:
- a. The Respondent applied for a Utah resident producer individual insurance license on October 17, 2023.
- b. In his application, Respondent answered "yes" to the background question that asked, "have you ever been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a misdemeanor".
- c. On January 6, 2020, Respondent was convicted of Retail Theft, a Class B Misdemeanor. Respondent was ordered to pay a fine of \$680.00 and criminal restitution of \$25.86. The case was closed on November 16, 2020. (*See* Ogden City vs. Dallon Creed Slaughter, Case # 191802310, Ogden City Justice Court, Weber County, State of Utah).
- d. Pursuant to Admin. Code R590-281-4(1), because of Respondent's misdemeanor criminal conviction, Respondent is not eligible to apply for a Utah insurance license until four (4) years have elapsed from the date Respondent was released from probation and his criminal case was closed, or November 16, 2024.
 - 4. The above declared facts demonstrate that the following Utah insurance laws were

not complied with:

a. Respondent violated Utah Code § 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(xiv), by having been convicted

of a misdemeanor involving fraud, misrepresentation, theft, or dishonesty;

b. Respondent violated Utah Administrative Rule R590-281-4(1)(e), by applying for a

license prior to the end of the required time period resulting from Respondent's criminal

misdemeanor conviction;

c. Respondent violated Utah Code § 31A-23a-105(5)(a)(ii) by committing an act that is

grounds for denial, suspension, or revocation as set forth in Section 31A-23a-111;

d. Respondent violated Utah Code § 31A-23a-107(2)(a)(ii), by failing to meet the

trustworthy character requirement;

e. Respondent violated Utah Code § 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(i), by being unqualified for a

license under Utah Code § 31A-23a-104, 105, or 107; and

f. Respondent violated Utah Code § 31A-23a-111(5)(b)(ii), by violating an insurance

statute, a rule that is valid under Subsection 31A-2-201(3), or order that is valid under

Subsection 31A-2-201(4) as outlined herein.

5. Based on the facts and law set forth above, Respondent's application for a resident

producer individual insurance license should be denied.
