Dear Mr. Davis,

Together with the 18 U.S.C. §1033 Advisory Committee, I reviewed your Application to Utah Insurance Commissioner for Written Consent to Engage in the Business of Insurance Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 1033 and 1034 (“Application”) dated June March 22, 2022. I have also reviewed the information you provided regarding your expungement.

Based upon your Application, as well as an internal legal review of your information, I have determined that your Application is denied. Please be aware that since you do not have the required written consent, it would be a felony for you to engage or participate in the insurance business.

In accordance with Section 8 of the Utah Insurance Department’s Process for Written Consent under 18 U.S.C. § 1033 (“Process”), my decision on an Application is final. A prohibited person has no rights to reconsideration or appeal.

Section 9 of the Process an Application may not be submitted more frequently than once per year.
